Degree Type	Year s	Total Est. Cost	Includes
1 Year Certificate/Diploma	1	\$3800-\$6800	Tuition and fees. Each program has different supply requirements.
Associate's Degree/ Technical Degree	2	\$15,000-\$18,000	Tuition, fees, books, supplies
Associate's Degree to Bachelor's Degree	4	\$40,000-\$100,000	Adds in 2 years at Bachelor's degree, and up to 2 years of dorms.
Bachelor's Degree	4	\$50,000-\$160,000	4 years of expenses and up to 4 years of dorms.
Master's Degree	6	\$80,000-\$200,000	4 years Bachelor's Degree and 2 years Grad School
Doctorate Degree	8	\$140,000-\$200,000	4 years Bachelor's and 4 years Grad School

Attending USC Lancaster for 2 years, then transferring into a 4-year degree, will save you \$40,000 on average.

Applying for Financial Aid



- **FAFSA**
 - Free Application for Federal Student Aid
 - www.studentaid.gov
 - Available October 1st
 - Priority April 1st
 - •Fall semester Deadline August 1st
 - Apply for Grants, Work Study, Student Loans

Grants



- > Federal Grants
 - •Pell is for families with incomes < \$90K
 - •Up to \$7395
 - •SEOG limited funds, \$1000 at USCL
- > SC Need Based Grant
 - SC Resident
 - •SCNBG for SC Residents, up to \$3500
- > Lottery Tuition Assistance
 - SC Residents not receiving LIFE
 - Reduces tuition and fees
 - Up to \$1920 per year (\$80 per credit hour)

Palmetto Fellows Scholarships

- •\$6700 1st year, \$7500 2nd year
- •To qualify:
 - SC Resident
 - •Top 6% Class Rank in 10th, 11th or 12th grade year
 - •3.5 GPA (SC UGS GPA)
 - •1200 SAT/25 ACT
- •OR 4.0 GPA and 1400 SAT/31 ACT
- Apply in your Senior year



LIFE Scholarship

- **•**\$5000
- SC Resident
- To qualify at a 2 year college
 - •3.0 GPA (SC UGS GPA)
- •To qualify at a 4 year college, meet 2 of 3
 - •3.0 GPA
 - Top 30% of Graduating Class
 - •1100+ SAT/22+ ACT
- Years of potential Eligibility at USCL, 4 Years total
- •Can earn it going into your 2nd year

- SC Resident
- To qualify at a 4 year college only
 - •3.0 GPA (SC UGS GPA)

USCL Scholarships

- > USCL Scholarships
 - Lancer Scholars: Due Nov 1st

- 4.0+ GPA \$3500
- Foundation Scholarships: Due Feb 1st
- 3.0+ GPA \$1250-\$2500

Late Scholarships: Due Aug 1st

- 3.0+ GPA \$750
- > Renewal Requirement: 3.0 USC GPA and 30 earned hours
- > Renewal Bonus: 3.5 USC GPA and register by May 1st +\$500
- Emergency Textbook Scholarship: Up to \$375 for books
- > Lancaster County Textbook Scholarship: Covers Online Book Access
- > Lancaster Opportunity Scholars Scholarships: Summer grant
- > Other Student scholarships: links on our website

➢Work Study

A job that works around the student's schedule

Self-Help Aid

- >Stafford Loans
 - Loans the student borrows that has no payments until after leaving college
- >Other Loans
 - Loans the student borrows with a cosigner and payment starts immediately
- >PLUS Loans
 - Loans the parent borrows. You can delay payment but not interest



UNIVERSITY OF SOUTH CAROLINA LANCASTER

- > 98% of USCL students receive some grant or scholarship
- > The typical Statent receives \$7,250 in Scholarships and grants
- > The typical non-Resident receives \$16,780 in Scholarships and grants
- > 40% of students borrow loans
- > The average loan borrowed is \$5880
